

Frequently asked questions about the transfer to the HPC



No. Hearing Aid Dispensing is a legally protected function, and Hearing Aid Dispensers must be registered with the HPC.

2) What qualifications are needed by new starters and existing RHAD?

New starters will need a Foundation Degree, or an accredited BSc or MSc (most BSc & MSc Audiology courses are not accredited and do not lead to registration as an HAD). Existing RHADs will not require any further qualifications.

3) Can a Paramedic or an NHS employee who is already in the HPC, start dispensing Hearing Aids?

No, only those on the register of Hearing Aid Dispensers can dispense private aids. NHS audiologists etc who wish to dispense aids must undertake additional training and examinations in order to become Hearing Aid Dispensers.

4) Will I be automatically transferred to the HPC?

Yes. This should already have occurred.

5) What is the new registration fee, and will I have to pay for being a Ltd Company? By now you will have received

details of the registration fee. This only applies to individuals, not employers or companies. The current fee is £76 a year.

6) Will I still call myself an RHAD?

You may. The protected title is Hearing Aid Dispenser, but my understanding is that there will be no objections to you using the letters RHAD after your name.

7) Can I use the word Audiologist to describe myself under the HPC?

Your HPC title is Hearing Aid Dispenser. At present the term 'Audiologist' is not protected, and Audiologists are not yet a registered profession, so I believe it would not actually be illegal to call yourself an Audiologist in adverts etc. However it might be deemed misleading by both the HPC and Trading Standards – in which case you would be asked to stop. I would avoid using the term.

8) Can I call my practice a clinic under the HPC?

As long as it does not mislead the client it would be ok.

9) Do I need to collect CPD points?

No. You must undertake relevant CPD activities, but there is no need to collect a certain number of points. It is up to you to decide what you need and to prove to the HPC that you have undertaken sufficient CPD. Attending conferences and meetings is probably the easiest way of building up a decent CPD portfolio. Of course, if you are a BSHAA member you do still need to collect BSHAA points.

10) Will I get audited as we did with the HAC?

Yes. The HPC will audit a selection of dispensers to ensure they have undertaken sufficient and appropriate CPD.

11) Can I employ staff and train them to fit hearing aids after the test?

You must be registered as a hearing aid dispenser if you carry out the protected functions (assessing or testing an individual's hearing, or prescribing an aid, with a view to the sale of an aid). Students on HPC approved courses (i.e. Foundation Degree, BSc & MSc) may undertake these functions as long as they are correctly supervised. As students work through their degrees they will gain more skills and require less supervision. The role of other staff is less clear. An assistant who is not undertaking an approved degree course would not be allowed to undertake full assessments or prescriptions. Using an assistant to fit an aid that you have



prescribed may be frowned upon, and if a complaint occurs the HPC will deal with it on a case by case basis. It might be considered that, as fitting an aid requires skills in programming, it should not be delegated to an unregistered person. I suspect this question will be sorted out if and when the first case goes before the HPC. (My personal view is that I would not delegate the fitting of an aid to another person as I think it's the most important part of the process.) If an assistant undertakes a screening test they must be appropriately trained and supervised. The term 'appropriately' has not been defined, however BSA accredited courses are available in both Audiometry and Impression Taking. It could be argued that someone holding a BSA certificate in either of these tasks

Using assistants for minor repairs and service work is unlikely to cause problems.

is competent.

Whatever you delegate to another person, remember that you are always responsible for their actions.

12) What action can the HPC take if a complaint is made about me?

If you are found guilty, following an HPC investigation and hearing, the penalties range from: no sanction; mediation; caution; condition of practice order; suspension and, finally, striking off. If you receive a caution or condition of practice order, this will be recorded against your name on the register. Don't forget that Trading Standards may also take action against you, if they feel you have treated a client unfairly or have broken consumer protection laws, and they can impose heavy fines. Both HPC and Trading Standards have a policy of prosecuting only if it's in the public interest.

13) What size of fines can we expect if anyone is found guilty of any breach of regulations? None. The HPC do not levy fines or award costs, even if a registrant is found guilty.

14) Is the HPC self funding as was the HAC?
Yes

15) Will there be a separate website for dispensers as there was with the HAC?

Yes. The HPC has dedicated pages for us on its website.

16) Will there be more stringent controls over internet advertising?

This is not specifically an HPC issue, other than adverts must not be misleading. Advertising is governed by the Advertising Standards Authority and Trading Standards.

17) Do I still need to use a Recommendation form with Trial period and price on?

This is governed by Trading Standards. There is no legal requirement to provide a receipt when you sell something (unless you are VAT registered). However clear terms of trial periods, guarantees etc must be provided. It might be deemed misleading if you sold an aid without providing full written details as in the old HAC receipt. so I would strongly advise the use of a decent receipt. If Trading Standards believe that you have misled a client through not providing adequate information, you could be found guilty of a criminal offence.

The above opinions are based on my interpretation of HPC regulations etc. I have done my best to be accurate, but do not treat my comments as professional legal advice.

Revelation in Hearing Technology, well seeing actually.

Danish designer Mads Hindhede from Denmark has come up with an ingenious design in glasses with act as a visual hearing aid.

They may look like something that Jonny Depp wore in Alice in Wonderland but they actually work.


Sound is received via two microphones built into the glasses and with now perfected speech to text translation software, can be converted into text. This is projected onto the lenses via video projection software from HMD technology.

Noise - filtering software is used from proven hearing aid technology, and the unit itself can is powered by a Li-ion battery.

'...please do not adjust your TV set, that sound is 80,000 football fans blowing into their VuVuzelas...'

It has been reported that a University in South Africa has carried out research on the ubiquitous African Horn to discover an alarming finding that they can produce a deafening 131 db from a single blow.

This would be the equivalent of sitting in a stadium full of jackhammers all digging on concrete at the same time. The research showed that levels of this magnitude and intensity are both unsafe and can put people at risk of noise induced hearing loss.
